



## Notice regarding Sale of Carbon Credits

LNG Japan Corporation (President and CEO: Kyo Onojima; Headquarters: Chiyoda-ku, Tokyo; hereinafter referred to as the "Company") hereby announces that it purchased carbon credits from Sojitz Corporation (Representative Director, President & CEO: Masayoshi Fujimoto; Headquarters: Chiyoda-ku, Tokyo) and sold these today to Hokkaido Gas Co., Ltd. (President: Hiroshi Ohtsuki; Headquarters: Sapporo, Hokkaido).

These carbon credits were certified by a highly credible certification agency for CO<sub>2</sub> emission reductions achieved by environmental conservation projects.

The Company has been engaged in the LNG (liquefied natural gas) business for half a century since the 1970s and contributed to the stable energy supply through upstream development, production, and transportation businesses in the LNG value chain.

Going forward, while fulfilling responsibilities for development and stable energy supply with focus on LNG and natural gas, the Company will proactively work to achieve carbon neutrality (net-zero CO<sub>2</sub> emissions) of its activities through carbon credit trading, Carbon-Neutral LNG (Note 1) trading, CCUS (Note 2) businesses, etc. to contribute to the realization of an environmentally-friendly and prosperous society.

(Note 1) Carbon-neutral LNG: LNG that produces net-zero CO<sub>2</sub> emissions; the CO<sub>2</sub> generated in its life from the mining of natural gas to the final consumption (combustion) is offset by the carbon credits created by environment conservation and other projects.

(Note 2) CCUS: Abbreviation of carbon capture, utilization, and storage. Technologies aimed to reduce greenhouse gas emissions by capturing, utilizing, and storing emitted CO<sub>2</sub>.
