

LNG Japan Corporation Secures
Long-Term Gas Sales and Purchase Agreement with Alinta Energy

LNG Japan Corporation (“LNG Japan”) has entered into a long-term Gas Sales and Purchase Agreement with Alinta Energy WA Pty Ltd (“Alinta Energy”) for the supply of more than 30 petajoules of natural gas through LJ Scarborough Pty Ltd.

Through LJ Scarborough Pty Ltd, we hold a 10% participating interest in the Scarborough gas field development project and intend to supply gas to the Western Australian domestic market over the life of the project.

Under this agreement, we will supply a portion of this gas to the domestic market through the early 2030s, supporting stable and reliable gas supply and contributing to energy security in the state.

This agreement represents LNG Japan’s first domestic gas supply arrangement in Australia and marks an important milestone in the development of our business in the country.

Jeff Dimery, Managing Director & Chief Executive Officer of Alinta Energy, said:

“This agreement strengthens our gas portfolio and supports our ability to provide reliable and flexible energy for our customers in Western Australia. Natural gas will continue to play an important role in the energy transition, supporting our generation assets and helping to firm renewable supply.

We are pleased to work with LNG Japan and look forward to further developing our partnership.”

In collaboration with JOGMEC, we are participating in the Scarborough gas field development project and will continue to promote responsible energy development and supply while giving due consideration to environmental and social impacts.
